WHAT IS CISM?

Critical Incident Stress Management

A comprehensive crisis intervention system that mitigates the symptomatology of Post Traumatic Stress Disorder.

CISM is a process that facilitates a return to mental and emotional normalcy after a traumatic event.

GOALS

Develop a cadre of trained CRN Responders to serve all schools.

Mobilize a team of Responders upon request.

Facilitate a countywide collaborative for ongoing dialogue regarding crisis response.

Develop standardization and protocol for CISM training.

Deliver aftercare service to schools in time of need.

ACTIVITIES

Build a collaborative with mental health, police, fire, and Emergency Medical Services.

Conduct a Critical Incident Stress Management training to build responder base.

FAQ'S

Q: How do schools access the services of CRN? Contact the CRN Coordinator listed on the back of this pamphlet.

Q: Under what circumstance would schools call? When schools have exhausted all of the resources that would effectively manage a crisis.

Q: What is the liability of CRN personnel servicing kids and staff? The CISM model is not therapy. The team offers only psychological and emotional first-aid.

Q: How long can CRN Responders commit to staying on site to assist? The CRN Team can commit to providing services to schools for up to two weeks.
