TROUBLE IN THE HOOD – POLICE INITIATED LOCKDOWN

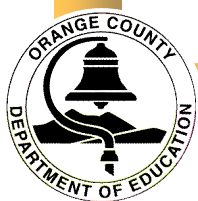
Lockdown procedures (shelter-in-place) are often a result of police activity in the school neighborhood. This course will offer best-practice procedures for all types of lockdowns.
